PISA PLUS is a waff programme supporting employees who seek to complete an apprenticeship or lower secondary school, or want to attend continuing vocational training courses.

For better career opportunities

You might have found a job – nevertheless, it pays off to invest in continuing vocational education:

- ▶ It is an active contribution to securing your job.
- ▶ It will give you more opportunities if you want a career change.
- ▶ It will help you to use any vocational qualifications acquired abroad in your career in Austria.

What can you get support for?

- ▶ Completing secondary lower school
- ▶ Completing an apprenticeship by taking the final exam outside the regular system
- ▶ Continuing vocational education or training

How much support can you get?

- Up to **2,000 euro:**
- ▶ for completing certain apprenticeships or
 - ▶ for completing secondary lower school
- Up to **1,100 euro:**
- ▶ for continuing vocational education or training.

Who can get support?

- Employees who are registered as having their main residence in Vienna, who are over 18 years of age, and who either
- ▶ have not completed secondary lower school, or
 - ▶ who have not completed in stage in education above compulsory schooling,
 - ▶ who are over 40 years of age, or
 - ▶ who cannot use their vocational qualifications for a career in Austria because these were acquired abroad.

- ▶ your apprenticeship occupation,
 - ▶ suitable continuing education and training,
